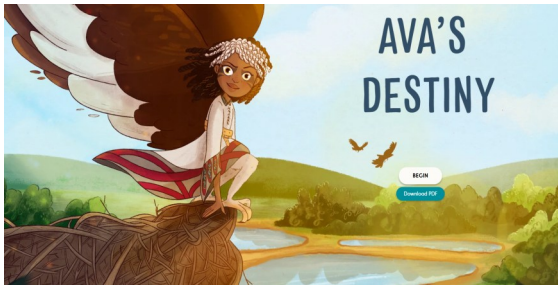
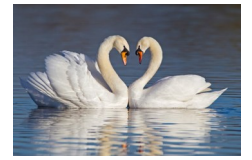

As part of Science Week we are taking part in The Big Plastic Count For Schools. Make sure you complete your sheet.



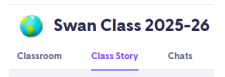
