Next Thursday 5th March is World Book Day! Children can come to school dressed as a character from a book.

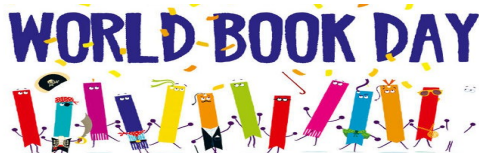

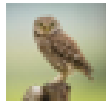

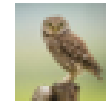

We have been learning all about electricity this term. We experimented with different circuits and investigated the different components needed to make electricity flow.



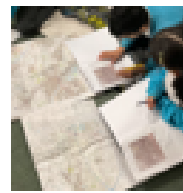
English

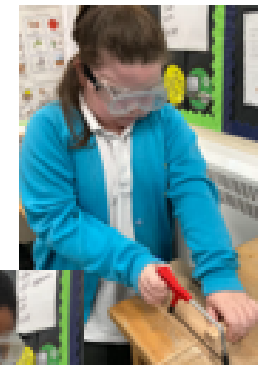
Geography
