We are amazing :)



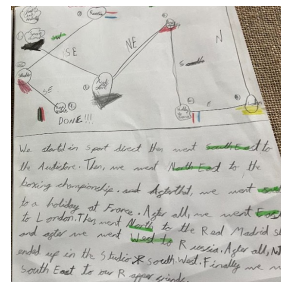
In Music, we have been learning a new song called - People Of The Future. We have learnt sign language alongside the song.
