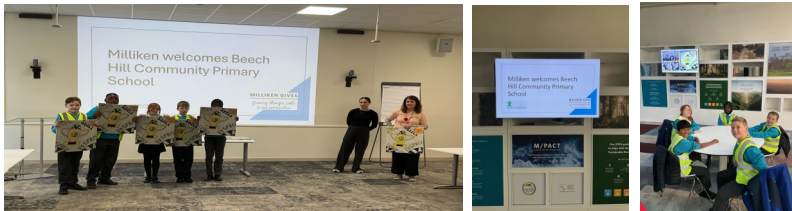
HEADLICE

We kindly ask all parents to check their children’s hair regularly, ideally at least once a week, for headlice. It is best to check for headlice by wet combing using a special fine-toothed comb (detection comb) which you can buy online or from pharmacies to remove head lice and nits. If you find live headlice you can obtain treatment for free at your local pharmacy. It’s important to note that children should only be treated for headlice if live lice are found.
