Osprey Class

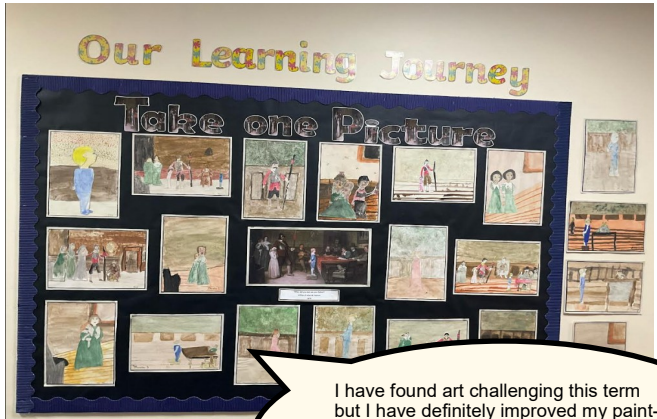

I enjoy music lessons because I am continuing to learn and I know that I am getting better. - Millie



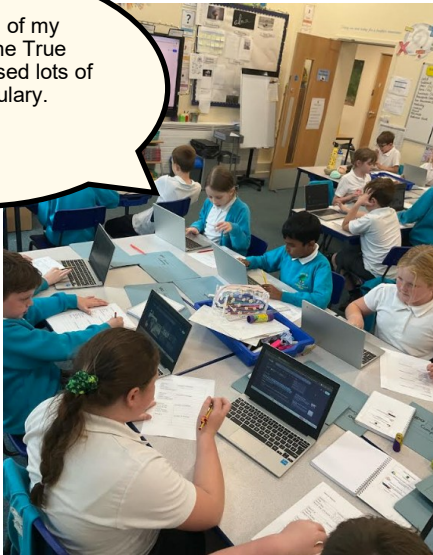
Our Learning Journey
