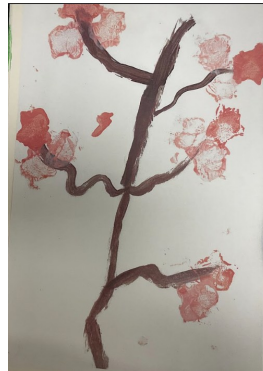

We have printed beautiful blossom pictures in our art lessons..

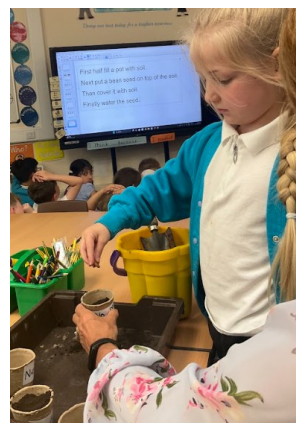


We went on a plant hunt to find out what plants were growing in our school grounds.
