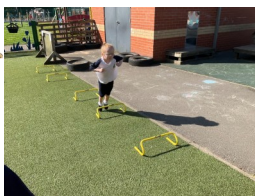
We had a very busy spring term in Reception. Here is a look back at some of the things we got up to.
