A huge thank you to the lovely team at Milliken, the children had a fantastic day!

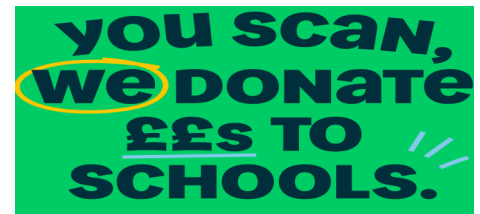


ASDA REWARDS APP

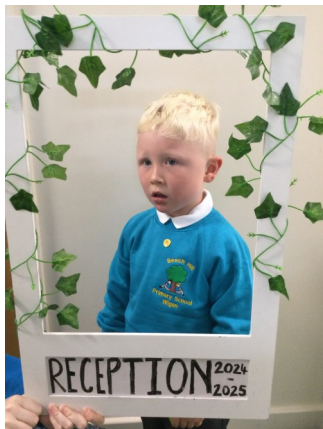
