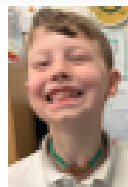


English: One Plastic Bag

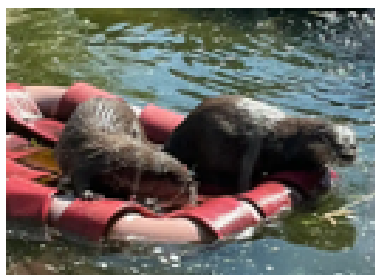
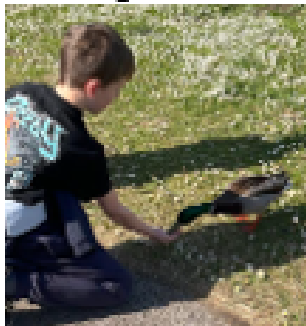


We enjoyed helping each other, learning how to crochet is not as easy as it looks!
