



WARM WEATHER

We know this week has been difficult due to the extreme heat. Please see the advice below from the UKHSA to stay safe during the heatwave.

- If you are going to do a physical activity (for example exercise or walking the dog), plan to do these during times of the day when it is cooler such as the early morning or the evening
- Keep your home cool by closing windows and curtains in rooms that face the sun
- Drink plenty of fluids
- Know the symptoms of heat exhaustion and heatstroke and what to do if you or someone else has them
- Try to avoid direct sunlight, especially between 11am and 3pm when UV levels are highest
- If you are going out during this time, cover up with suitable clothing, wear a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses, seek shade and apply sun screen liberally and re-apply frequently

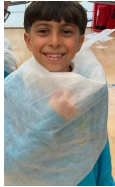

We have produced amazing 3D collage in Art.



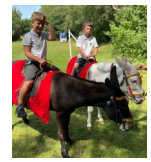
We completed First Aid Training!
