OUR PARENTING PROGRAMMES



The Nurturing Programme

Supports parents to develop positive relationships with their children by exploring behaviour, communication, emotional wellbeing and understanding children's needs.



Togetherness Teen

Designed for parents and carers of teenagers, helping families strengthen relationships, improve communication, and confidently navigate the challenges of adolescence.



Riding the Rapids

A series of age-specific programmes supporting parents of neuro-diverse children through key developmental stages:

- Preschool
- Primary
- Secondary

These programmes aim to help parents to understand and manage challenging behaviour shown by their child.



Youth Connect 5

Supports parents and to improve communication, emotional wellbeing, build stronger connections and promote positive family relationships.



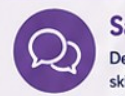
Family Transitions

Helping separated parents adjust to significant changes such as separation, blended families, bereavement, or other transitions, while understanding the impact of parental conflict on children and supporting children's emotional wellbeing throughout these changes.

Our parenting programmes are available for parents, carers and families living in Wigan Borough. Professionals are encouraged to discuss the programmes with families and support referrals where appropriate.
